2009 AIR Forum Grant Program

The AIRUM Steering Committee is pleased to provide the opportunity for a grant to the 2009 AIR Forum. One award of \$750 will be given to an AIRUM member to help cover part of the expense of attending the Association for Institutional Research 49th Annual Forum in Atlanta, Georgia, May 30th-June 3rd, 2009. AIR is the national organization for institutional research and AIRUM is the upper Midwest regional affiliate of AIR. AIRUM believes that attendance at the national forum is stimulating and rewarding and the grant offers members an opportunity to attend the meeting.

Eligibility

In order to be eligible for the grant, an applicant must:

- 1) have attended the annual fall AIRUM conference at least once in the last two years (2007 or 2008);
- 2) have never previously attended an AIR Forum;
- 3) demonstrate it is unlikely that institutional funds are sufficient to cover the full cost of attending the AIR Forum;
- 4) be willing to provide the AIRUM membership with a short Forum report; and
- 5) complete the following requirements.

Requirements

A short (one-page) maximum request addressing the following items must be submitted by March 1, 2009:

- An explanation of why you want to attend the AIR Forum.
- A short description of financial need.
- A brief description of your current duties.

Selection Process

All applications must be postmarked no later than March 1, 2009 and will be carefully reviewed by the AIRUM Steering Committee. Applicants will be notified of the Steering Committee decision by March 15, 2009.
