

AIRUM History

Organizational milestones

- 1973—first AIRUM conference held
- 1979—AIRUM members voted to seek affiliation with the national Association for Institutional Research organization (AIR)
- 1980—it only cost \$35 to register for the conference including meals and an evening special event
- 1981—the AIRUM constitution was drafted
- 1983—first AIRUM newsletter was started
- 1983—conference evaluations initiated to help in future conference planning
- 1983—AIRUM logo created by Tim Hoyt (University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh)
- 1988—first grant offered to AIRUM members to attend AIR national conference (AIR matched AIRUM funds)
- 1993—first AIR conference grant offered by AIRUM (given to help AIRUM recipient attend AIR for the first time)
- 1996—first AIRUM conference scholarship offered (given to help recipients attend AIRUM for the first time)
- 2008 – new AIRUM logo created by Jamie Lueck, A Northwestern College(IA) student
- 2009 – first joint AIR/AIRUM IPEDS Pre-Conference Workshop offered.
